

Creation of Matter at the Center of the Galaxy Paramahamsa Tewari January, 2016

The above sketch shows the sun orbiting the center of the galaxy carried by the underneath velocity field of the galactic vacuum vortex. The velocity field increases towards the sun as inversely proportional to the square root of the distance from the center of the sun until it reaches the velocity of light [relative to the vacuum] thus starting the creation of matter starting from electrons and positrons.
